UPDATE ON RECTOR RECRUITMENT

The recent advertisement of the vacant Rector's position gave rise to a promising applicant. However, that person also applied for a position in another parish which he was offered and which he accepted. It is therefore necessary for us to advertise the position again.

We are taking advice from senior figures in the Diocese on the options for managing the vacancy and the recruitment of a new Rector. It seems likely that that publication of the advertisement of the vacancy will be deferred until after Christmas with a view to interviewing promising applicants around Easter 2023. The reason to delay the advertisement is that the timings of the interviews and of starting in the role could make the position of interest to the group of curates (who will include a number of people who have started their training for ministry after several years in the workplace) who will be completing their training.

The period between now and the end of the year will be used to revise the brochure; that is the document which provides potential applicants with information about the benefice and the three parishes. The brochure which was prepared in 2021 was written as we came out of the worst of the restrictions arising from the COVID pandemic. The parishes have settled back now to a more stable pattern of activities and this needs to be reflected in the brochure.

Work is also underway to make sure that the website materials that are available from the three parishes are up to date and that there is consistency across the websites which reflects their links through the Benefice.
