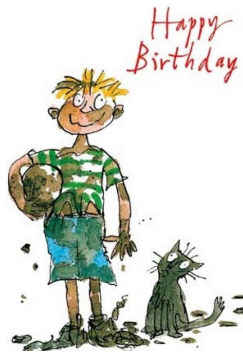

## Barwick in Bloom Coffee Morning

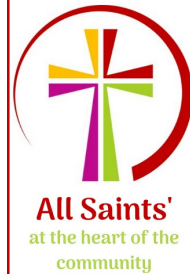
Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> September
