The prophets who foretold the birth of Jesus

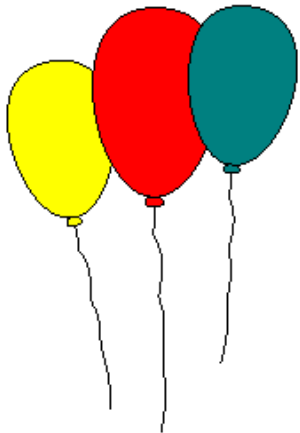
